

CHECKLIST

- ☐ Keep decking boards clean, dry and out of direct sunlight before installation
- ☐ At least 12" air circulation below the decking structure. This allows adequate air flow.
- ☐ In placing decking boards for installation, allow 1/4" span between boards due to wood expansion.
- ☐ Positioning of pilot holes should be 3/4" from the end. 3/4" from the edge of boards.
- ☐ Consult your contractor for the best hardwood finish. Make sure stain is for hardwood and contains a UV protector.
- ☐ Finish all 4 sides with oil based wood preservative for tropical hardwoods.
- ☐ The ends of deck boards must be waxed. We recommend AnchorSeal®.
