



Color Collection - Blue Steel Touch-Up Application Process

Blue Steel is achieved by applying Charcoal as a base coat then applying Whitewash over the top. This is done with machines at the manufacturer.

When touching up it is recommended to:

- 1) Practice 1st we recommend testing on junk boards for practice.
- 2) Apply Charcoal and look to see if Whitewash is needed.
- 3) If it is needed to achieve the Blue Steel look, lightly apply a thin coat of Whitewash over the top of the Charcoal using a small bristle brush. Apply additional thin coats of Whitewash as needed.

Be careful not to apply too much Whitewash from coat to coat.

We recommend only touching up the end cuts.

We don't recommend attempting to touch up the face of the product. This can possibly alter the original stain color and not blend well.
